

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

General

ALPSTEIN CROSSING is an extreme sports event. Every participant has to have sufficient condition and experience in the discipline Hike&Fly. At the check-in every participant has to sign the conditions of participation. Likewise, the associated race briefing is obligatory for all participants.

Starting permission

All persons who have reached the age of 18 are eligible to start. For younger participants (absolute minimum age is 16 years) the declaration of consent of the legal guardian(s) is necessary at the latest when signing the conditions of participation.

Starting Fee

The entry fee per athlete is fixed at CHF 80.00. The entry fee per team (CHF 240.00) is due for the regular registration before the race and will be collected by the organizer after the registration.

Cancellation of the registration

A team can withdraw from the race. Cancellation must be reported at any time to the race management or to registration@alpstein-crossing.ch. Cancellation can be made free of charge up to one month before the race. For cancellations after July 31, starting fees cannot be refunded. The starting fees will then be charged to the team.

If ALPSTEIN CROSSING is cancelled due to force major, the organizer reserves the right to withhold CHF 30.00 of the paid starting fee per team. In case of such cancellation, CHF 210.00 will be refunded to the team accordingly.

Personal responsibility

It is the personal responsibility of the participant to take part in ALPSTEIN CROSSING. If the race is cancelled or interrupted during the race, the instructions of the race management have to be followed. The race takes place mainly on public grounds. The rules of the regulations in force in the traffic or the alpine area must be strictly respected. The organizer declines any liability.

Health

With the participation, the participant confirms to be in perfect health condition and to be up to the requirements of ALPSTEIN CROSSING.

COVID-19

The participant hereby confirms not to have any symptoms of the pandemic with COVID-19. Participants showing symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home immediately. The participant confirms to abide by the regulations of the organizer and the public authorities.

Race Rules

The race rules are part of the conditions of participation. By signing the conditions of participation, the participant declares to have read, understood and accepted the Race Rules. The rules will be explained again at the race briefing. Otherwise, the Race Rules can be viewed or downloaded on the website. The organizer reserves the right to change the Race Rules until race day. Namely, turnpoints or their scoring may be cancelled or postponed due to weather conditions.

ALPSTEIN CROSSING 2021

Fairness

Unfair or dangerous actions of any kind towards other participants, crew or public persons will lead to immediate disqualification. A further registration with ALPSTEIN CROSSING will be blocked for the following years. The race committee decides alone and united about the disqualification.

Environment

The race takes place in the alpine region of Alpstein. The participant has to take care that the racecourse or surrounding landscape is polluted as little as possible.

Race Riot

Protests against the decisions of the race committee will be accepted until 18:00 on race day. After that time, there is no right to appeal or protest the race result. Protests must be submitted in writing. No further appeal is allowed against the final decision of the race committee. The race committee decides about the protests until the announcement of the classification at 20:00 o'clock.
